

While I have been doing other tasks and completing important aspects of my life, this book remained on my mind, and I kept feeling unfulfilled until I got it into the hands of readers all over the world.



Thinking about it, however, is not doing it. If you spend more time thinking about doing it than actually doing it, then you are not truly Following-Through. On the other hand, waiting is more spiritual. For example, the scripture says, “Wait on the Lord and be of good courage” (Psalm 27:14, King James Version). While waiting, you can seek God’s face and pray about what you know that you need to do. The difference between waiting and procrastination deals primarily with prioritizing. Everything that you procrastinate about does not necessarily mean that you will not reach your destiny. Use the spirit of discernment to determine if that “thing” is something that God means for you to complete, because it just might be a part of the ultimate plan for your life and purpose.

The spirit of discernment plays a pivotal role here in terms of allowing the Holy Spirit to help you know the voice of God.

It requires inclining your ear to hear a word from the Lord that will allow you to distinguish between what you need to Follow-Through on versus those things that are not the tasks that God has predestined you to do.

Q1 Please tell us a little about you (where you were born and raised, children, hobbies, etc.)

I grew up in Michigan and I have one daughter (Carmyn and a son-in-law Oluwaseun). I am married to Dana Michael Bruce and we share a feisty Yorkshire Terrier and his name is Mackie. I love riding my bicycle, walking, reading, writing and spending time with my dad, family and friends.

Q2 What is your purpose and passion in life (what are you passionate about/your gift)?

My purpose and passion in life is to use my voice and writing skills to put words together to uplift through Spirit. I love supporting people to Follow-Through on their Dreams, Visions and Goals (DVGs). One of my spiritual gifts is praying for others and I'm passionate about exercising and using my gift to pray for others.

Q3 Please tell us a little about what motivated you to write your book? How many books have you written?

This is my first book. I am a professor and an ordained itinerant elder in the African Methodist Episcopal Church. I was motivated by God to write this book on Follow-Through. Everything that I have had a chance to do in life, that I wanted to do, I was able to experience when I Followed-Through on the "unction" of the Holy Spirit to take an action step towards a goal or desire.

For example, I always wanted to travel to the continent of Africa. One year, I was attending a conference in Washington, D.C. and I saw there was an opportunity to travel to Senegal (West Africa). I attended a Consortium International Management Policy and Development (CIMPAD) Conference in Dakar, Senegal, West Africa. It was then that I Followed-Through with writing a proposal on the topic of HIV/AIDS and examining how journalists framed this issue in newspaper articles. My proposal was accepted and as a result, I earned the opportunity to fulfill my dream of traveling to the continent of Africa!

I wanted to pursue my Ph.D. I earned my Ph.D. because I Followed-Through and never quit. There were some semesters that I took only one course at a time. I then took my qualifying exams. I Followed-Through and finished the dissertation.

I realized that the success that I have achieved to this day has really been when I Followed-Through on completing things that were important to what I felt was connected to my purpose and according to my relationship with Christ. It is because of these kinds of experiences that motivated me to write this book.

During my life, I've seen people start things and say they really want to return to school, start a business, complete their estate plan, or other plan, but for some reason they dropped the ball. I believe that God has called me to inspire

people to Follow-Through on fulfilling their purpose in life. That is the inspiration behind what made me write this book.

Q4 What would you tell a new and upcoming author about writing? Any suggestions for new authors?

You have to block out time to write. I recommend having an accountability partner to hold you accountable to a writing schedule. Set a timeline for different tasks to be completed. And affiliate yourself with a writers' guild or group.

Q5 What do you do in your quiet/down time?

I like to visit with my family, as well as writing and sending cards. When my mom died, the fact that she left me cards with her handwriting...I really value handwriting and I'm very concerned that handwriting will become obsolete with computers. So, I handwrite cards to my family and friends in my down time.

Q6 When people encounter you and walk away, what do you want them to say about you as a person/an author?

I want to ignite people to start! I want them to feel inspired to start what they've had on the backburner.

It's more than just motivated. I want people to walk away feeling ignited and fired up to complete whatever it is that they know in their spirit that they need to finish! The fire was always in them to start but it wasn't ignited. As a result of hearing me speak or them reading my book, they are ignited to let their flame burn, and thus motivated to get it done!

When people walk away from me as an author, I want them to be inspired and excited by my story, testimony and tenacity to get "things" done. I want them to believe that they too can Follow-Through and complete what they have been afraid to start. My audiences will be infused with hope to complete those things that have kept them awake at night. I want people to walk away saying, "Rev. Dr. Bruce is infectious with inspiring me to focus on and Follow-Through on my Dreams! She makes me feel and believe that I can do it!

I want people to be curious about what is on the other side after they have actually Followed-Through. I want them to feel that sense of accomplishment. I want them to be positioned to see what is next and what they are feeling led to complete. I want people to have that wonderful feeling that I can trust myself to Follow-Through on what God has for me to do, and I will fulfill my purpose.
